NACTA is holding 2nd national essay writing competition (English & Urdu) on following topics mentioned against each category:

Category	Topic

Rules:

Participants will be required to strictly follow the following prescribed rules, failing which their entry will be rendered ineligible:

- Essay may be written in English or Urdu language as per topic assigned to each category.
- The word count for the essay is mentioned against each category. Word count must be mentioned at the end of the essay.
- Essay must be original and will be checked for plagiarism. References, must be properly mentioned at the end of the essay.
- English essays must be typed in Times New Roman, Font size 12, Line spacing 1.5
- Urdu essays may be typed and converted to PDF or hand written using single side of the page.
- All Participants should send their essays via post or email: nactaoutreach@gmail.com along with copies of their ID cards, and contact numbers before Saturday, 30th April 2022
